- Help share our story visually with various audiences: general public, donors/stakeholders, prospective candidates, volunteers, etc.
- Join pertinent department and organizational meetings as needed

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in Adobe Creative Suite (Illustrator, InDesign, Photoshop)
- Experience managing multiple deadlines for both short and long-term projects
- Knowledge and understanding of content curation across mediums and platforms
- Commitment to the missions of both AL & ALTEF entities
