KEN PAXTON ACQUITTED

Corruption Remains Rooted in the Texas Republican Party

Austin, TX: In response to the acquittal of Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton, Annie's List released the following statement on behalf of **Executive Director, Ana Ramón**:

"The impeachment trial proceedings were a major step towards holding corrupt Ken Paxton accountable, but ultimately Paxton has been given a pass and will no doubt continue to misuse the Office of the Attorney General for his own personal gain and political grandstanding.

"Even in the face of damning testimony, Texas Republicans will take whatever measures necessary to protect their own. We cannot put any trust in the GOP's ability to lead after acquitting Ken Paxton, and the danger they pose to our state should not be understated. Actions like this and the propping up of shameless elected officials like Paxton are indicative of a Texas where corruption knows no bounds.
